Grand Champion Points

At the judge's discretion, Grand Championship points may be awarded to: Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog, Select Bitch.

Judge's Awards of Merit

Immediately following the Best of Breed competition, the judge may select, at her discretion, up to 5 of the superior quality specimens from the intersex competition. She is not required to award any, and may not award more than the number allowed based on the number showing. These would not include those exhibits previously awarded Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog/Bitch, or Winners Dog or Bitch. (Explained further with number available, on page 11)

Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch Majors

At the national specialty, dogs designated Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winner's sex total at least twice the number required for a five-point major in the region in which the event is held. Only those dogs actually competing are counted.

2024 SDCA NATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES

SDCA STANDING RULES FOR SWEEPSTAKES & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

The handler of an exhibit in the Scottish Deerhounds Club of American Futurity or Sweepstakes at the National Specialty shall not be a professional handler or handler assistant, a household member or employee. A professional handler is any person who has been a member of a professional handler association; listed as a professional handler by the American Kennel Club; has represented themselves as a professional handler, advertised as such, or received compensation for handling dogs at any specialty, group or all breed show within two years of the date of the specialty in which the exhibit is entered. Notwithstanding this prohibition, professional handlers may exhibit, at the national specialty, their own dog(s) of which they are owner, co-owner, breeder or co-breeder.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

The Scottish Deerhound Club of America Sweepstakes is open to all breeders and owners of Scottish Deerhound dogs and bitches who on the day of the show will be 6 months of age and over, and under 18 months of age. No AKC Champions of record are eligible. Dogs shown in Sweepstakes **MUST ALSO** be entered in one of the Regular Classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry form. Indicate 'SWEEPSTAKES' as an additional class and indicate the class division. Indicate Sweepstakes class with the age division. Entry fee for the Sweepstakes class is \$18.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES CLASSIFICATION (Classes for Dogs and Bitches)

- Puppy, 6 months and under 9 months
- Junior, 12 months and under 15 months
- Puppy, 9 months and under 12 months
- Junior, 15 months and under 18 months

The winner of each class will compete for Best Puppy in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Veteran Sweepstakes will be judged after Puppy Sweepstakes. Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Scottish Deerhound dogs and bitches who on the day of the show will be over 7 years of age. Entrants need not be intact. Dogs entered in the Veteran Sweepstakes **MUST ALSO** be entered in another class at this show. Indicate VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES on the entry form in addition to the other other class and indicate the class division. Entry fee for the Veteran Sweepstakes is \$18.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES CLASSIFICATION (Classes for Dogs and Bitches)

- Veteran, 7 Years & Under 9 Years
- Veteran, 9 Years & Older

The winner of each class will compete for Best Veteran in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Veteran Sweepstakes.

NOTE: There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Junior Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee also applies.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present, it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS - This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. --- Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

CLASSIFICATION

REGULAR CLASSES (Classes for Dogs and Bitches)

- Puppy, 6 mos. and under 9 mos.
- Puppy, 9 mos. and under 12 mos.

NOTE: Bred-By-Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility (revision 9-02)

1. All dogs entered in the Bred-by-Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC, AS OF THE DATE OF THE EVENT.
2. The person handling the dog must be both a breeder of record and an owner of record of the dog.
3. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a registered breeder and owner of record.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES - SINGLE DOG ENTRIES - for Dogs and Bitches

Veteran Classes -- • Dogs 7-9 years of age • Dogs 9 years of age and over

NOTE: AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Chapter 11. Sect. 8. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veterans Classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed. This is an independent specialty.

AKC Field Trial Class -- This is a class for dogs that have placed first, second, third, or fourth in an AKC or ASFA Field Trial. Entrants must be intact.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES - MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Stud Dog Class - For Stud Dogs and at least two (2), but not more than four (4) of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog class and shown in the ring with his Get. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular classes at the regular entry fee of \$35, with 'Stud Dog' class indicated on the entry form in the space for additional classes at an additional \$25. Or, the Stud Dog may be entered in Stud Dog class ONLY for a \$35 entry fee.

All Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes, but there is no additional entry fee for them as participants with their sire in this non-regular class. The Get only will be judged, on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or being excused under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for the Breed.

NOTE: AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Chapter 11. Sect. 8. A castrated male may be entered as Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

Brood Bitch Class - Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog, Produce for Get.

Brace Class - A brace is defined by AKC as two (2) dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising the Brace pair must be named at the time of the entry and each MUST BE entered in an additional class. Brace entry fee is \$12.50 per dog.

NOTE: Effective January 1, 2005. A brace is defined by AKC as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in Brace must have one common owner.

Team Class - 4 dogs performing in unison, presented by a maximum of 4 handlers. Dogs competing must have at least 1 common owner. Each dog involved must be entered with full details on his own regular entry form, and each MUST also be entered in another class. The entry fee for each dog participating in TEAM is \$8 per dog.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

AWARDS OF MERIT -- The judge may, at her discretion, choose up to five (5), based on the number available entrants that show exceptional quality deserving of an Award of Merit, excluding Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Winners Dog and Winner Bitch. None are required to be awarded, and no more than the available number may be given. Based on the number exhibiting in the BOB Class, the number available to the judge are:

- 1 AOM for 8 - 12 dogs
- 2 AOM for 13-17 dogs
- 3 AOM for 18-22 dogs
- 4 AOM for 23-27 dogs
- 5 AOM for 28 dogs & over

BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR -- Best Bred-By-Exhibitor will be selected from the *winner of the Bred-by-Exhibitor Dog & Bitch Puppy & Adult Classes* following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition.

BREEDER AWARDED BEST BRED-BY IN SPECIALTY -- one free AKC Litter Registration offered by AKC.

BEST NOHS -- Best Owner-Handled will be selected from dogs *exhibited by their owner* that are not professional handlers. Exhibitors must declare their dog Owner-Handled eligible at the time the entry is made, on the entry form. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Dogs exhibited by professional handlers, current assistants and household members of a professional handler on the day of the event, are not eligible to enter this competition. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS. Best NOHS will be selected after Best of Breed judging from dogs remaining in the ring that are eligible to compete in BOB, including WD & WB, providing they have not already been defeated in the ring. Consult www.akc.org/ohs for complete rules and judging procedure, or see the Show Secretary.

BEST VETERAN DOG and BITCH -- will be selected from the winners of the Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch Classes, and **BEST VETERAN IN SPECIALTY** from those two winners, following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition.

BEST PUPPY -- Best Puppy will be selected from the Puppy classes following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition. Only winners of the 6-9 mos. and 9-12 mos. classes are eligible to compete.

2024 SDCA OBEDIENCE & RALLY TRIAL

OBEDIENCE & RALLY JUDGE: MELVIN R. STANLEY

Qualifying Score required for all prizes in Regular Classes. 'Dog' means either sex. Transfers will be allowed per AKC regulations.

A Dark Green Rosette will be awarded to each dog receiving a qualifying score. A refund of entry fees for bitches entered in Obedience or Rally that come in season after the closing date of a trial may be obtained provided that a veterinarian certificate and a request in writing is received by the Show Secretary by 30 minutes prior to the start of regular obedience or rally judging.
